Train services

Trains to Ashford (William Harvey Hospital)

Ashford International is the nearest rail station to the William Harvey Hospital. It is a short walk from the town centre, from where 'bus service 5' runs every 15 minutes. Bus services 10 and 11 also run directly from the station to the hospital. These services both run about once an hour.

There are regular direct train services to Ashford International from Tonbridge, Paddock Wood, Margate, Ramsgate, Dover and Folkestone, as well as many other stations.

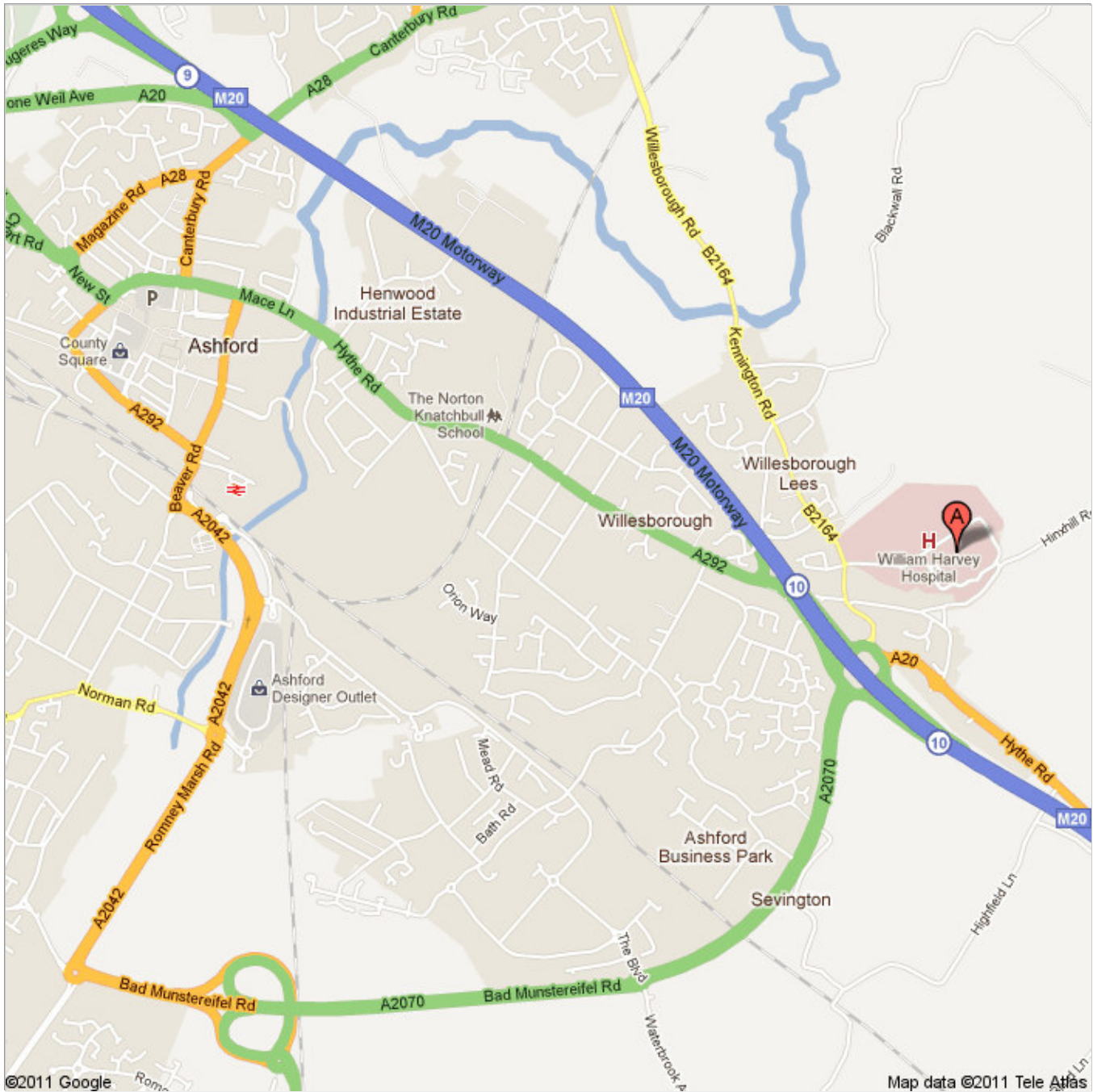

All car parking at William Harvey Hospital, Kent and Canterbury Hospital, Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother Hospital, and Buckland Hospital is pay and display.

Pay and display costs

East Kent Hospitals parking costs

Number of hours stay	Cost
0 - 2 hours	£2
2 - 3 hours	£3
3 - 4 hours	£4
4 - 5 hours	£5
6 - 24 hours	£8

Pay and Display charges may also be paid through [RingGo](#), which is a cashless method of paying for your parking. Details are posted on the pay and display machines, and you will require a mobile phone and debit or credit card to use this service. Please note there is a 20 pence convenience charge for using this service.

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Drop off zones

There are 'drop off' zones outside key areas of the hospital. If you are taking your relative/friend to a hospital appointment you can use these areas to park for 15 minutes free of charge while you 'drop off' your friend or relative.

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Disabled facilities

There are disabled bays near the main entrances of the hospital where parking for disabled badge holders is free for up to three hours. Current charges apply if parking in a standard pay and display bay.

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Weekly parking permits

If you need to visit the hospital several times over an extended period, our weekly parking permit can cut the cost of parking.

Details of how to buy a parking permit at our hospitals can be seen below:

William Harvey Hospital

The permits can be obtained from the parking hut (at the top of the main car park, opposite the main entrance). Pay and display tickets to the value of £12 need to be purchased from the pay and display machines and given to the parking attendant, along with the ward name or department you are visiting. Cash payments are not accepted. Alternatively write a cheque for the sum of £12 made payable to East Kent Hospitals University NHS Foundation Trust and hand it to the attendant.

Hospital Park+Ride

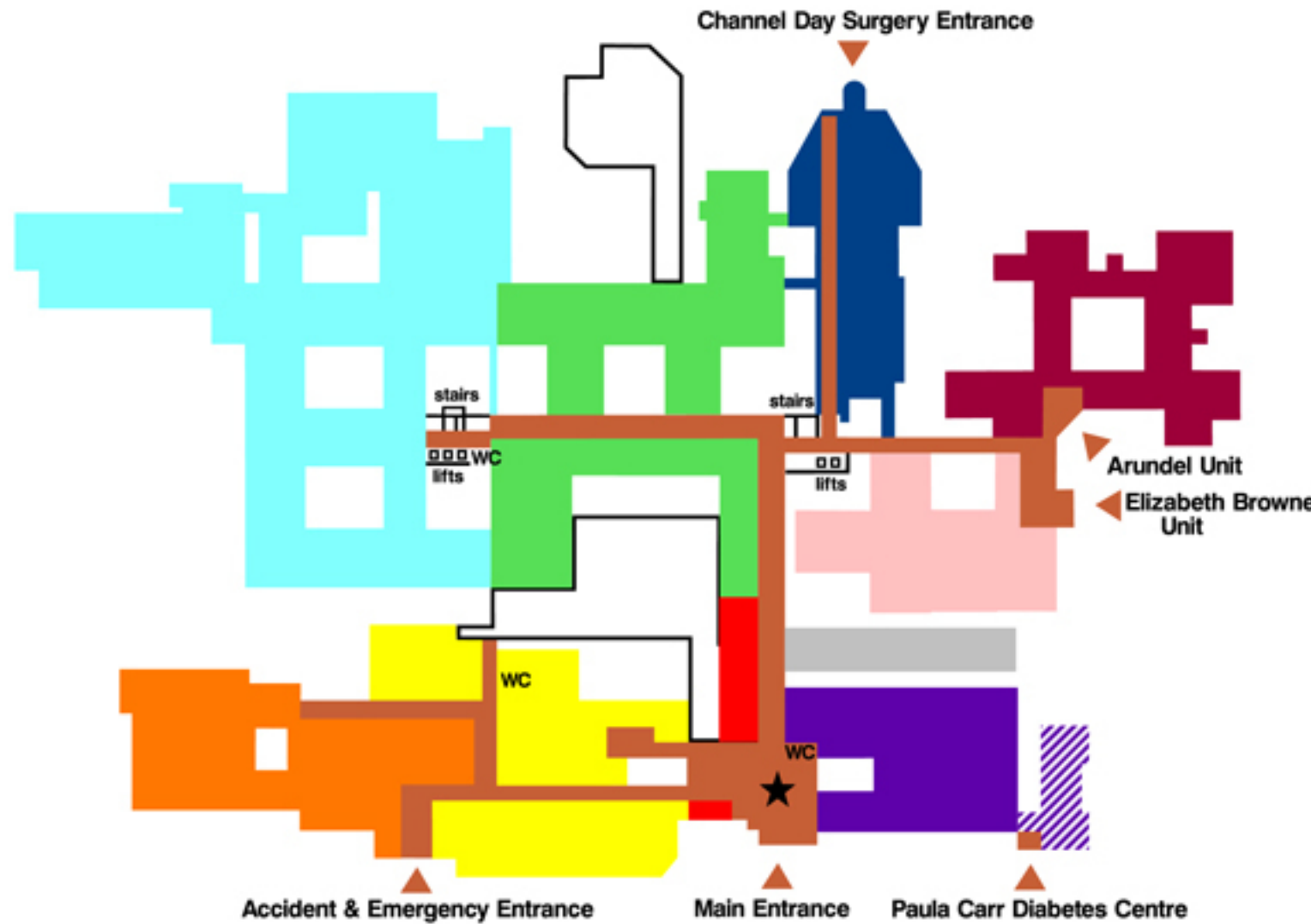
Patients and visitors at Kent & Canterbury Hospital now have the option of using the **Park & Ride** Service from New Dover Road, Park & Ride car park. Dedicated buses run every 20 minutes from 08:00 to 18:00 Monday to Friday. Charges are £2.50 (£2.00 if using a pre paid card) for parking and bus transfer to the hospital.
